To be qualified, you must be at least ONE of the following:

1. Those who are legally blind – your vision in the better eye is 20/200 or less with correcting glasses, or your widest diameter of visual field is no greater than 20 degrees.
2. Those who cannot see well enough or focus long enough to read standard print, although you wear glasses to correct your vision.
3. Those who are unable to handle print books or turn pages because of a physical handicap.
4. Those who are certified by a medical doctor as having a reading disability due to an organic dysfunction that is severe enough to prevent you from reading in the usual manner.
5. (Certified Authority) Professionals who work with those who qualify as blind, visually impaired or print-handicapped (1-4) .
